In prison, Paul had many problems to worry about. In fact, he had every reason to be an expert worrier.



Yet, out of this context he wrote the wonderful formula that can stop worry in its tracks: "Don't worry, pray!" When you pray, you talk to God sincerely about our concerns, laying them before Him so He can manage them. Don't allow worry to steal your joy and peace. Give it to God.

Hatfield Church of the Brethren – FOOD CUPBOARD

In early December we completed our Winter Coat Project for our Food Cupboard families. Through our congregational giving, matching Everence funds, the Hatfield Pastors Fund, and some neighborhood contributions we were able to provide 186 children, 12 years or younger, with either a winter coat or a \$25.00 gift card. Thank you for all your support.



Also, we were the recipients of \$2,500.00 from the Hatfield Police Benevolent Fund and an additional \$1,700.00 from the Hatfield American Legion through Grace Lutheran's Angel Box program. These funds are currently being used to provide each Food Cupboard family with a \$25.00 Walmart gift card as a holiday / new year's gift. In addition to gift cards, we received several hundred pounds of personal hygiene products – always highly requested items on a Food Cupboard Day!



Our two main suppliers, SHARE and Philabundance, provided additional food selections for the holiday season which helped fill out our pantry shelves, produce tables, freezers, and refrigerators. It allowed us to save a lot of our state grant money. So, looking ahead, we should be in good financial shape through the end of our fiscal year in June 2024.

Our next opening is on Tuesday, January 2, 2024. Hope you can be there and bring in the new year with our Food Cupboard families!
