COMMUNITY OUTREACH . . . FOOD CUPBOARD



June 30th ends our financial year with July 1st the beginning of our new year. We have \$1,700.00 remaining in the 2023-2024 grant which must be spent in the first two weeks in June, or the remaining amount will be lost. (There will be no problem spending the money in the two-week time frame!)

The PA Department of Agriculture Food Security is responsible for determining the amount we receive (as is SNAP) - traditionally, however, it is one of the last portions of the budget to be passed. Last year we waited until mid-October before we were informed

what our grant would be, resulting in no grant funds for four months! Hopefully, this year's wait will not be as long, but considering the current political climate, I'm not holding my breath!

We continue to have a great relationship with SHARE which is responsible for distributing the state funds to the various food distribution agencies in Montgomery and Philadelphia counties. While I am confident, we will receive our "fair share" of the state distribution, I'm not as comfortable with the state maintaining an amount equal to the 2023-2024 budgeted amount – remembering that it was decreased from the year before. Fingers crossed!

I need to repeat what I wrote in our April Newsletter: "I hear so often, 'We love to come to your food cupboard! Everyone is so friendly and welcoming. Other pantries just don't seem to be interested in us, but yours seems to like to talk to us. Thank you, so much.'" Our families recognize that we care who they are and that they matter. A great example of what an early Brethren businessman put outside of his printing press:

"For the glory of God and our neighbors good".

Thank you to all our Food Cupboard volunteers! Keep up the good work showing how God's love is our guiding light!
