

We served 117 families with 498 family members in May. There were 7 new families who signed up to receive food going forward. Memorial Day fell on the fourth Monday and while we normally would be open, we were closed in observance of Memorial Day. Due to this, the first Tuesday of June 6/3/2025 will likely be busier than normal.

We are blessed with generosity around us. One of our families in the community donated \$100. We received 25 dozen eggs from another donor, who has donated eggs before. The Post Office food drive dropped off a substantial amount of donated food. A donation was made by our church to the food pantry in honor of Mother's Day and Father's Day.
