"Embracing lament in our Lenten Journey" - this is the theme of our Community Lenten journey this year. The Bible is filled with examples of faithful people of God offering up sorrowful or even angry prayers to God. Even Jesus laments over Jerusalem and weeps at the death of a friend. To lament, to grieve, to weep - these are all parts of the life of faith. Often, we are too quick to push aside the uncomfortable feelings of grief and loss. We have lost in some ways, the spiritual disciple of lament: acknowledging the grief that is part of everyday life, holding it, and then placing it gently (or forcefully!) in God's hands. This Lent we will explore the laments found in scripture and relearn the discipline and the gift of holy lament.

Suggested readings: Lamentations 3:19-26; Psalm 42; Psalm 88; Psalm 13; Psalm 44:-10, 13, 17-26.
