#### FOOD CUPBOARD NEWS . . .

Fall is just around the corner and that means school is about to open. For the last several years, we were involved with Hatfield Community Christian Coalition (H3C). They sponsored a variety of outreach projects for the community, food cupboard friends and day care. They are now defunct.



One of the projects they sponsored was the Backpack project.

Since school is about to open, I was hoping to raise some funds from our congregation to continue the project with our Food Cupboard friends. If you are interested and would like to donate, let me know ASAP.

The last two months for the Food Cupboard have been difficult. As you may know we are regulated by the State and Federal Department of Agricultures. Most of our food and grant monies come through them. Their fiscal year runs from July through June of the following year. So, what do we all know when you mix "government" with "fiscal"? It involves a "budget" – which for most entities is passed before the beginning of the new fiscal year. However, with governments, passage of the budget is after the new fiscal year. Most years the state budget is passed by mid-July – which the grant monies we will be receiving. This year the state budget wasn't signed until mid-August and the rumors are the grant money will be less than recent years – possibly even less then pre-COVID years. We should be okay fiscally, but starting in September, families will again only attend once a month.

Thank you volunteers who stepped up while I was out in June.
