#### **OUR CHURCH IN ACTION**

#### FOOD CUPBOARD NEWS . . .

July 1<sup>st</sup> is the beginning of the Food Cupboard year (7/01/24 – 6/30/25) – which is the State of Pennsylvania's fiscal year. Once the PA budget is approved, which includes the Department of Agriculture's budget, we then know what amount our grant will be for the coming fiscal year. However, since budgeted monies do not get carried over from one fiscal year to the next, we are without any funds until the budget is approved. Because of the politics involved, it often takes months of wrangling before the budget is approved – some years, like last year, it was not settled until October! This year the budget was approved in July, and we were awarded a satisfactory amount of \$10,000.00 which works out to \$1,000.00 for each of the remaining months. With these funds we can purchase food from two different vendors: Driscoll Foods and Derstine's Foodservice.



We still have funds in our Food Cupboard budget which we spend an average of around \$250.00 per food cupboard opening from Derstine's. We usually can fill in the needed fresh vegetables like potatoes, onions, lettuce, and tomatoes. Since they are small orders, we need to pick them up at Derstine's in Sellersville.

Not all our food is purchased. There are foods that are "no charge" to us but require us to order off menus and then pick up at various locations or be available for deliveries.

We pick up every Monday morning the other "fresh" (not always so fresh) vegetables at Manna in Lansdale. This produce is donated by Philabundance. We do not know in advance what is coming.

If you are wondering about our bread table, we pick up at Giant, in Hatfield, every Monday and Thursday – even on holidays.

We also can order from SHARE (a state sponsored agency) and Philabundance off their "free" order menus every week. While their menus can vary greatly from week to week, we are at times able to order canned vegetables, fresh vegetables, frozen meats, juice, cheese, eggs, cereal, pastas. What we order is delivered to the church on Friday's. While the delivery time is not known, we must be available when the truck arrives to unload.

We also can pick up eggs from Alderfer Eggs at no charge should we not be able to get them through SHARE.

This gives a portion of the pick-ups and deliveries that are made on a weekly or monthly basis. Just a tad of the behind the scenes working!
